



Student Dress Code 2017-2018

Shirts/Tops/Blouses/Jackets:

GRADES K-6:

- Collared polo or dress shirt/blouse, long or short sleeved, solid color or stripes are allowed in Grades K-6.

GRADES 7-12:

- Collared polo or dress shirt/blouse, long or short sleeved, any color, including solids, stripes, patterns or trim colors are allowed in Grades 7-12.

GENERAL GUIDELINES (GRADES K-12):

- No tank tops, sleeveless tops, spaghetti straps, shoulder cut outs, camisoles, etc.
- No hoods are allowed on any article of clothing, with the exception of athletic uniforms and are not allowed to be worn on the head.
- If shirt/top is not tucked in, it must fall below the waist, but not longer than approximately 3" below the waist.
- Turtlenecks are considered to be collared shirts.
- School-approved, commercially produced shirts representing the student's individual school are allowed.
- Solid color commercially produced crew-neck sweatshirts are allowed if a collared shirt is worn underneath.
- Commercially produced quarter-zip tops with a collar.
- Sweaters or sweater vests in all solid colors, striped, patterns and trim if a collared shirt is worn underneath.
- Dressy non-collared shell if worn with a sweater or blazer (tank tops, t-shirts, camisoles, etc. are not considered to be shells and are not allowed).
- Jackets without a hood may be worn if a collared shirt is worn underneath.
- Polo and collared shirts must be buttoned, usually two buttons from the top.
- No midriff may be exposed.

Khakis/Dress Pants/Shorts:

- Pants and shorts must be solid navy blue, black, gray, brown or tan/khaki.
- Pants and shorts must be worn at the waist and neither underwear nor skin shall be exposed. Both pant legs must be the same length. Pants must be fastened and if a belt is worn, it must be buckled.
- Shorts must be no shorter than fingertip length plus one inch (approximately mid-thigh/3" above knee).
- No blue jeans are allowed.
- No sweatpants, yoga pants, bib overalls, or pajama pants.
- No wind fabrics, leather, mesh, flannel/fleece, or nylon/vinyl/spandex.
- Leggings and tights are not to be worn as pants. Leggings and tights may be worn under a dress or skirt in solid navy blue, black, white, gray, brown or tan.

Dresses/Skirts:

- Dresses must have short or long sleeves.
- Must be no shorter than fingertip length plus one inch (approximately mid-thigh/3 inches above knee).
- Patterned dresses and skirts are allowed.
- No low cut dresses are allowed and undergarments are not to be visible.
- No leather, mesh, nylon/vinyl/spandex, see-through material or cutouts are allowed.

Additional Standards of Dress:

- Members of school-sponsored teams or groups may wear uniforms/team dress on the day of the game/performance/competition. No jeans are allowed.
- No flip flops or house slippers may be worn.
- Footwear must have a closed heel or back strap.
- Dress scarves are allowed. Scarves are not allowed as headwear, except for religious exemptions.
- Any item determined by the principal or designee to be too tight or revealing is not allowed.
- Winter coats may not be worn in class or cafeteria.
- Sunglasses, hats, ear guards, sweatbands, bandannas, hairnets, hoods and gloves may not be worn in school buildings.
- No chain wallets are allowed.
- Nothing depicting gang symbolism or affiliation is allowed.
